Shh... Save the Date: After you check into your hotel, it goes down something like this: The bus driver picks up a fiddler on the side of the road who steps on to provide some tunes. During the dinner, Elli Gateaux and Alli Gator emerge from the swamp, in search of their hitching site. The fiddler turns preacher and unites the gators. Guests get a Cajun two-step lesson and join in the post-matrimony fais -do-do (that means party). The gala is typically at **Beau Rêve**, a restaurant in a vintage home set on the water and known for fine dining.

PORT ARTHUR AND STARK CULTURAL

Rekindle your sense of wonder at Shangri La Botanical Gardens & Nature Center. On your two hour walking tour, observe nesting birds in **Shangri La's Ruby Lake** through a state-of-the-art bird blind. Pause to reflect in one of the 9 garden rooms or 4 sculpture rooms. Explore more than 300 species of plants in one of the most Earth-friendly projects in the world. Relax with a refreshing lunch at the Star & Moon Café then take a peak in the gift shop.

The Outpost Tour is a short walk to their Nature Discovery Center where visitors board a pontoon boat and take a short guided ride on Adams Bayou to one of the outposts in the Cypress/ Tupelo Swamp.

Next, head to the Museum of the Gulf Coast. The museum boasts the largest mural in the Southwest (125 feet) highlighting the region's evolution; a replica of Janis Joplin's psychedelic Porsche; the Sabine Banks lighthouse's original Fresnal lens; and music and sports halls honoring The Big Bopper of "Chantilly Lace" fame, Johnny and Edgar Winter, Olympian Babe Didrickson Zaharias, Coach Jimmy Johnson and others who called the area home.

Tonight, let your group relax with dinner at Larry's French Market where live Zydeco music and fresh Cajun dishes abound.





TRAVEL TO **CORPUS CHRISTI**

USA Today names **Texas State Aquarium** in the Top 10 aquariums in the US. Get carried away into the deep blue water. Located on North Beach, this stunning complex is home to fascinating sea creatures of all kinds. Dinner & entertainment tonight at Brewster Street Icehouse. Overnight in Corpus Christi.
